



Exhibition Policy and Submission Process

The 40 Acres Art Gallery is a nonprofit arts organization dedicated to exposing and educating the Oak Park and greater Sacramento community to a broad range of visual art forms. The 40 Acres Art Gallery is the central space in the 40 Acres Art Gallery and Cultural Center complex for showcasing museum-level exhibitions of nationally recognized artists. Underground Books, which is also located within the complex, is the art gallery's secondary art space, used to showcase local artists and community-based exhibitions.

40 Acres Art Gallery's exhibition season is planned at least a year in advance. However, the gallery is always interested in reviewing proposals for exhibitions. The selection process is highly competitive, but all submissions will be carefully reviewed.

The application packet should include the following:

- Contact information
- Resume/biography
- 20 Slides or a CD with digital images
- Press materials
- News articles about artist/artwork
- Related materials

Please do not submit original artwork.
